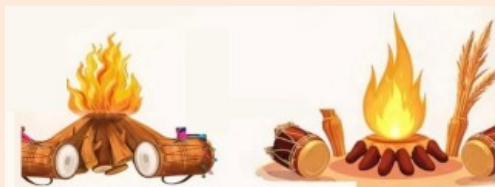

Rotary Club Chandigarh Tricity successfully conducted a Road Safety Awareness Programme on 28 January 2026 at the Regional Spinal Injury Centre (RSIC), Mohali. The program witnessed participation from over 100 attendees, including members of the general public, pedestrians, auto-drivers, and rickshaw pullers.

The event focused on creating awareness about road safety norms, traffic discipline, and responsible behaviour on roads, highlighting the importance of preventive measures to reduce road accidents and injuries.

Rtn Prof. Dr Raj Bahadur, former Vice Chancellor of Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, former Director of Government Medical College & Hospital, Chandigarh, and Director, RSIC Mohali, was the Chief Guest. His guidance and support played a crucial role in the smooth conduct of the event.

In his address, Dr Raj Bahadur spoke about the global contributions of Rotary. He emphasized the alarming rate of fatal injuries and deaths due to road accidents in India, stressing the urgent need for strict traffic discipline to minimize road mishaps.

The Keynote Address was delivered by Prof. Dr Manpreet Singh, Dept. of Anaesthesia & Intensive Care, GMCH Chandigarh. He presented an informative and visually rich presentation on the medical management of accident victims, covering critical aspects of first response, safe transportation from the accident site, and the precautions to prevent further injury. Dr. Harpreet also conducted a demonstration on CPR and the use of essential life-saving instruments.

Event Chair SP (Retd) Rtn Roshan Lal displayed exemplary leadership and coordination. He successfully collaborated with officials from Mohali Police and Chandigarh Police, including Inspector Manphool Singh and Senior Constable Rajiv, who delivered insightful presentations on the role of police in enforcing road safety measures. The importance of using ISI-marked high-quality helmets for two-wheelers and mandatory seat-belt usage in cars was strongly emphasized. People are encouraged to follow traffic rules not out of fear of enforcement, but to protect their own lives. Oath was administered to all attendees to comply with road traffic rules and safety measures.

In her address Councillor Gurpreet Kaur reinforced the message of road safety awareness and community responsibility.

मोहाली स्थित रीजनल स्पाइन सेंटर में रोटरी क्लब ट्रॉइसिटी चंडीगढ़ की ओर से नेशनल ट्रैफिक अवेयरनेस मंथ के तहत एक जागरूकता कार्यक्रम आयोजित किया गया। कार्यक्रम का उद्देश्य आम जनता को सड़क सुरक्षा, ट्रैफिक नियमों और सड़क दुर्घटनाओं से बचाव के प्रति जागरूक करना था। कार्यक्रम में डॉक्टर, पुलिस अधिकारी और समाजसेवी उपस्थित थे, जिन्होंने सड़क सुरक्षा में अपनी भूमिका और जिम्मेदारियों पर जानकारी दी। रीजनल स्पाइन सेंटर के ईचार्ज एवं बाम्बा फरीद यूनिवर्सिटी के पूर्व वहास चंसलर डॉ. राज बहादुर ने कहा कि देश में हर दिन सड़क



दुर्घटनाओं में सैकड़ों लोग अपनी जान गंवाते हैं। उन्होंने कहा कि तेज रफ़्तार वाहन न चलाना, नशे की हलत में वाहन न चलाना और नाबालिगों को वाहन न देना जैसे नियमों का पालन दुर्घटनाओं को रोकने में मदद कर सकता है। डॉ. हरीश सिंह ने सड़क दुर्घटनाओं में घायल व्यक्तियों को प्राथमिक उपचार देने के तरीकों पर प्रशिक्षण दिया। उन्होंने कृत्रिम सांस (सीपीआर), अधिक खून बहने पर पट्टी बांधना और हड्डी टूटने पर सुरक्षित तरीके से मरीज को अस्पताल पहुंचाने के तरीके सझा किए। कार्यक्रम में ऑटो चालक, युवा वर्ग, ड्राइवर और अन्य नागरिकों ने बढ़-चढ़कर भाग लिया, जिससे सड़क सुरक्षा जागरूकता बढ़ने का उद्देश्य सफल रहा।
